Veritas tuition includes all books and field trips. Tuition does not include school uniforms, school supplies or extracurricular program fees. There are no multiple child tuition discounts. We encourage families to apply for financial assistance if there is a financial need.

Tuition Assistance Veritas offers need-based financial assistance to families on a first-come, first-served basis. Levels of tuition assistance offered will depend on a number of factors including total (gross) family income, number of family members, number of children enrolled at Veritas, and any additional extenuating financial circumstances. To apply for tuition assistance, simply complete the FFNA (Family Financial Needs Assessment) application (available from the school office or online at www.ffna1.com) and submit it according to its enclosed instructions. It is expected that families will pursue every other available means of financial assistance (family, other scholarship funds, etc.) prior to applying for aid directly from Veritas School. Please note the deadlines on the "Admissions Checklist and Timeline" sheet.

Enrollment Deposit Families whose children have been accepted to Veritas Classical Christian School will receive an enrollment contract that must be completed and returned to the school. This enrollment contract must be accompanied by an enrollment deposit totaling one-tenth (1/10) of the family's total tuition obligation.

Payment Plans Veritas offers two different payment methods to accommodate the varying budgets of the community. Tuition may be paid in one lump sum or divided into equal payments throughout the year.

Uniforms A detailed list of specific clothing items and suppliers/vendors for the Veritas student uniforms may be obtained from the school office. Certain uniform items must be purchased from the designated suppliers and other items may be purchased wherever desired.

Waiting List In the event of a full class, a child may be placed in our wait pool after all other admission requirements have been fulfilled and application fees paid. You may withdraw from the wait pool at any time. Returning students will be given first priority in filling available spots. Second priority will be given to siblings of returning students. The remaining openings will be filled by new applicants on the basis of assessment results, teacher recommendation and family interview.
